# Goals & Objectives

- Provide additional classrooms and common space area to accommodate increased student enrollment.
- Increase student safety by connecting main building with auditorium and gym areas.
- Provide ADA accessibility to main and upper floors of PHS and new areas.
- Move administrative offices centrally to identify a school main entrance for students and public.
- Help alleviate lunch room congestion and lack of space in basement cafeteria

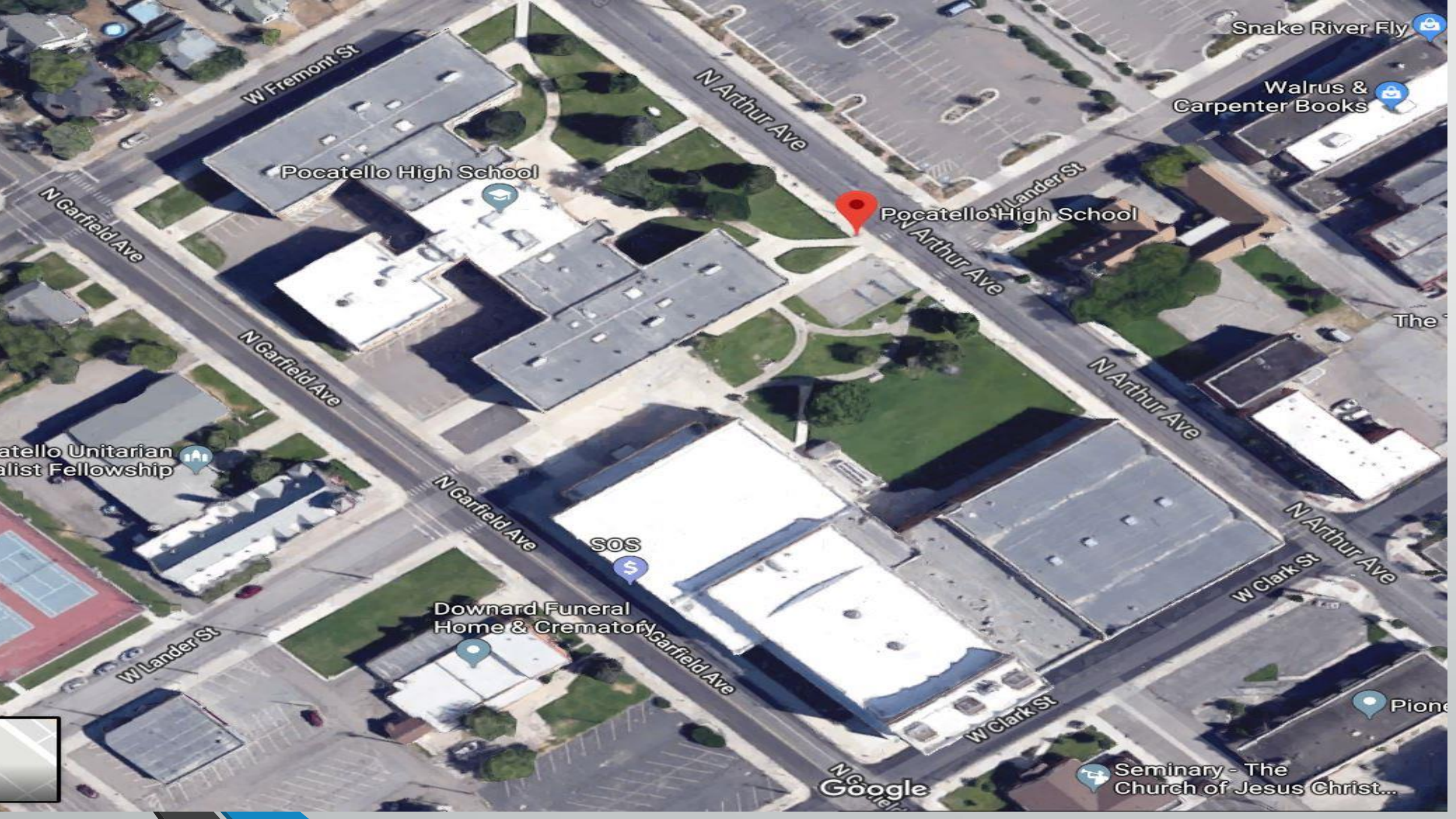


# Subsequent Discovery and Challenges

- The planned area between main school and gym has a 2' sewer main line and a 4' storm main line. Both lines are 25' deep and would be nearly impossible to relocate.
- City of Pocatello officials have indicated it would be highly unlikely they would approve building over these main utility lines.

- Architects should come prepared to make a 30 minute presentation to Board and share conceptual designs and ideas for project and answer questions.
