 - iii. **Student Docket No. 12-16** will seek out help if he feels he is falling behind.
 - iv. Goals for school activities.

Should **Student Docket No. 12-16** be provided any social services or health care services or be under the purview of the juvenile probation department, documentation will be entered into which permits a free flow of information between these individuals or providers and the school, only with regard to matters which impact upon his education.

Should **Student Docket No. 12-15** fail to meet the above stated conditions, violate any provision of the Behavioral and Academic Contract, or engage in any other major infraction of District or School Discipline Policies, **Student Docket No. 12-15** shall be brought back before the Board of Trustees for consideration of expulsion and revocation of the reinstatement to school. Should **Student Docket No. 11-01** violate any provision of the Behavioral and Academic Contract, or engage in any other major infraction of District or School Discipline Policies, **Student Docket No. 11-01** shall be brought back before the Board of Trustees for consideration of expulsion and revocation of the reinstatement to school.  - iii. The student shall model school citizenship.

Should **Student Docket No. 12-33** be provided any social services or health care services or be under the purview of the juvenile probation department, documentation will be entered into which permits a free flow of information between these individuals or providers and the school, only with regard to matters which impact upon his education.

Should **Student Docket No. 12-33** fail to meet the above stated conditions, violate any provision of the Behavioral and Academic Contract, or engage in any other major infraction of District or School Discipline Policies, **Student Docket No. 12-33** shall be brought back before the Board of Trustees for consideration of expulsion and revocation of the reinstatement to school. The voting was unanimous in the affirmative.
